Role of a Professional Coach

The Fox Valley Ice Arena is committed to quality in it's group class and private instruction offerings.

Discuss goals and expectations with your coach to create a plan and practice schedule. A general guideline for each 30 min lesson the skater should dedicate an additional 30 minutes of practice time to reinforce the lesson.

Your coach will help you make decisions in relation to testing and competing, if that is the route you choose.

Role of the Skater/Parent

As a skater, you should try hard, give your best effort, and pay attention to your coach.

If you are unable to attend a lesson, notify your coach in advance.

Each coach has personal billing procedure.

Make sure you know your coach's billing
policy and pay your bills in a timely manner.

Important Note

We do not allow coaches to recruit or solicit athletes that currently have a private coach.

Any athlete who currently has a private coach must consult their current coach before requesting lessons from another coach.

How do Private Lessons Work?

Private lessons are a great way to learn quickly while having fun. As with any learning situation, a student may progress more rapidly because of the one-on-one attention.

Each instructor acts as an independent contractor (usually rates run around \$30.00 per half hour).

Lessons may be 20, 30, or 60 min in length depending on scheduling and the age of the skater.

Students pay the coach directly for the lesson and pay the Fox Valley Ice Arena for use of the contract ice.

20 hour contract card ~ \$380.00
